Greetings,

We sincerely request a public hearing to determine whether the construction indicated on this building permit is truly compatible with other development in the immediate neighborhood.

For over 25 years, we have lived next door to 3530 Carlfield Street, which is the site address.

Our home is a decently sized (1300 square feet) single-story house in a pleasant neighborhood of mostly 900 square foot houses.

One downside of this neighborhood is that the streets were designed in the 1940's and are not really wide enough to safely accommodate the numbers of cars that people have today. There is no parking on the long south side of our block.

We have observed our neighbors constantly remodeling their house and adding more living space, without permits. We strongly feel that they are trying to connect the larger home to the "shed" in the back of the property.

Here are two key reasons we have a problem with our neighbor's plan to improve his property.

- The addition appears to add a dwelling unit (having kitchen and bathroom) with a bedroom to the building, If this happens, you then get more adults living in the building who park additional cars on an overly congested street. This is a public safety issue in the event that the neighborhood has a fire and many cars have to leave a narrow street in a short amount of time.
- Any addition to this building that adds people causes an additional safety problem. There
 is no exit on the San Pablo Dam Road side of the property. Anyone having to exit due to a
 fire would have to pass through a narrow pathway between the burning house and the
 fence between 3530 and 3524 Carlfield Street.

We are grateful for the opportunity to keep our neighborhood pleasant and safe. We look forward to a response and will gladly attend any necessary hearings required to ensure our neighborhood remains that way.


1 EXISTING PATIO ROOF FRAMING PLAN


2 EXISTING PATIO FLOOR FRAMING PLAN




3 EXISTING PATIO SECTION VIEW


