Dear Governor Brown:

In support of your decision to dissolve redevelopment agencies and in opposition to Senate Bill 1, (Steinberg/DeSaulnier), which essentially reinstates the power these agencies held, registered California voters have signed a Declaration urging you to veto Senate Bill 1 and any future Bill that seeks to create an "Authority" to manipulate and intimidate local communities for purposes of building redevelopment projects.

There are 711 signatures to this Declaration, crossing all party lines, and gathered within the past few weeks solely by word of mouth. Given more time before the commencement of the 2014 January legislative session, there would be thousands more. It is a testament to the public endorsement of your decision to place California on a sound fiscal path and end the corporate welfare, misuse of public funds, and abuse of eminent domain for which redevelopment agencies are well known.

Please read the Preamble and the signed Declaration in Opposition to Senate Bill 1. We signatories thank you for your attention to our effort and for your resolve to protect California taxpayers from the unsustainability and unconstitutionality of Senate Bill 1.
